

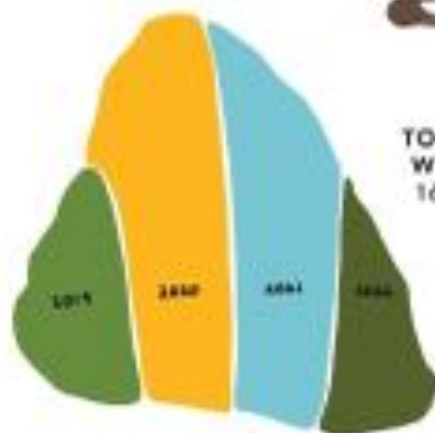

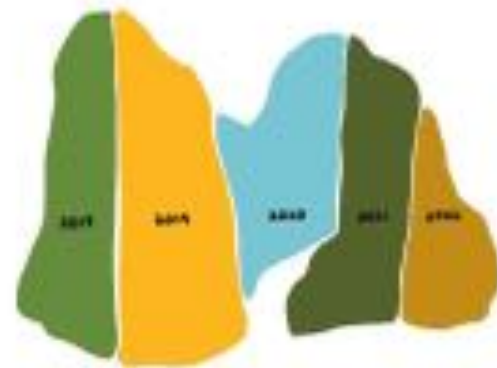


# 2022 Major Achievements

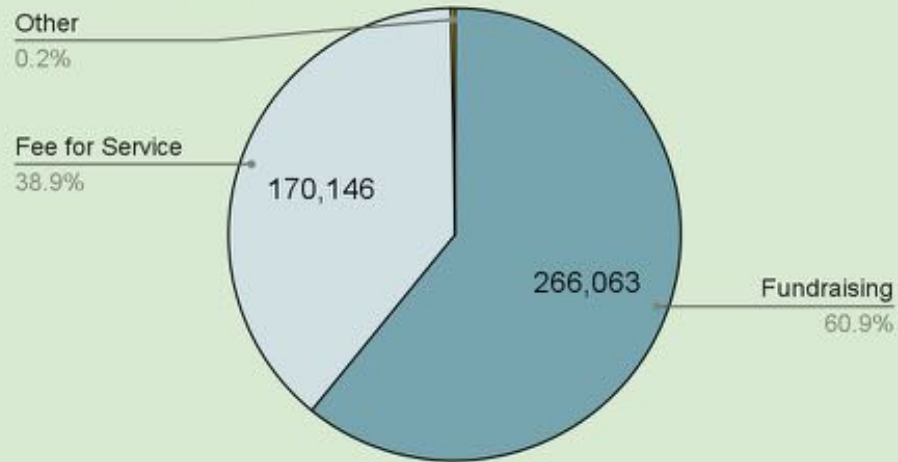
- Hired a part-time year-round Anchor Replacement Coordinator and Trail Coordinator

# 2022-2027 Strategic Goals

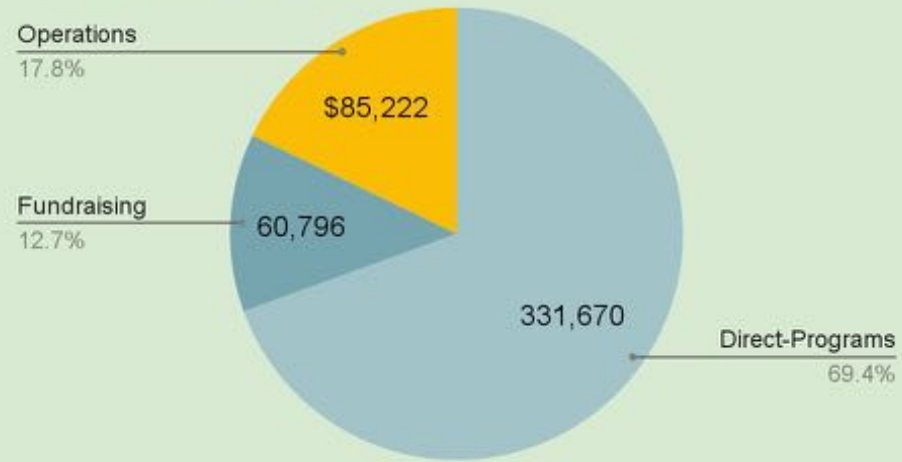
- Grow bolt replacement by 60%: Increase to 1,000 bolts a year from 500
  - Ensure a path to pooping within 20 minutes of every crag: more wag bags and composting toilets
  - Increase trail work capacity by 50%
  - Preserve and gain climbing access on the Front Range
  - Earn the reputation of BCC as the go-to resource for the Front Range climbing community
  - Replace 75% of aging bolts in Boulder Canyon
  - Expand Outreach and Education
  - Maintain or reduce the number of raptor closure violations year over year of BCC monitored areas

Revenue 2022: \$437,841

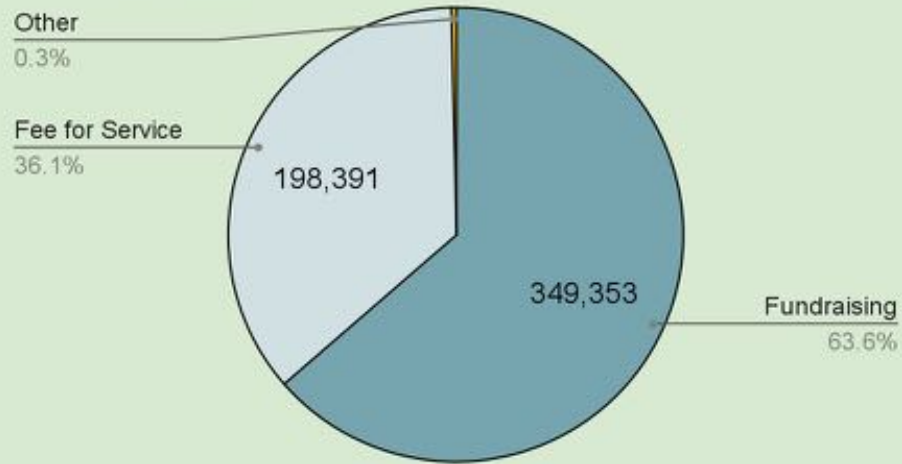


Expenses 2022: \$459,714

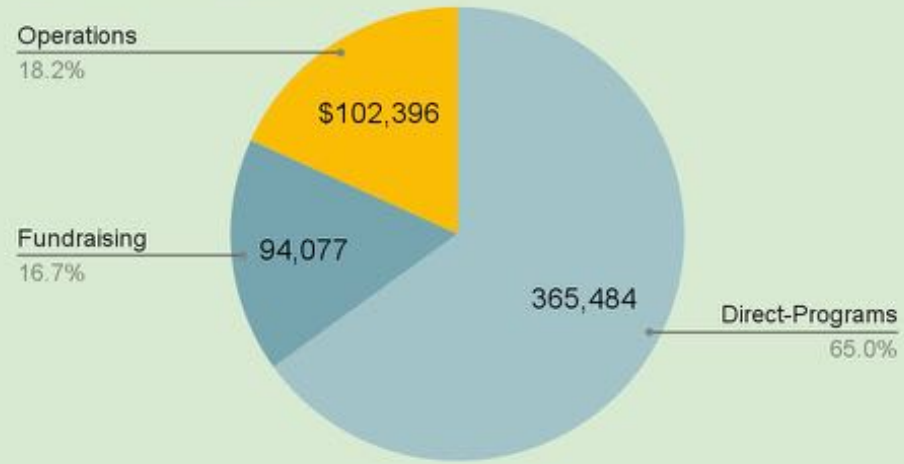


# Financial Health 2023

# Anchor Replacement Program 2022: Highlights

- Since being replaced, bolts updated in 2022 have already been clipped more than 20,000 times!
- Rebolted routes have seen over 2,000 ticks on new bolts!

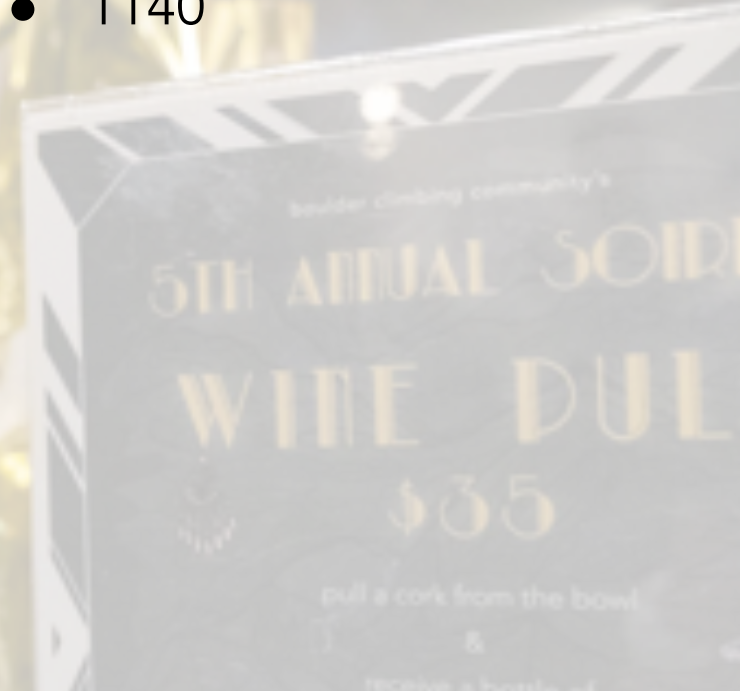

- 150 attendees and volunteers

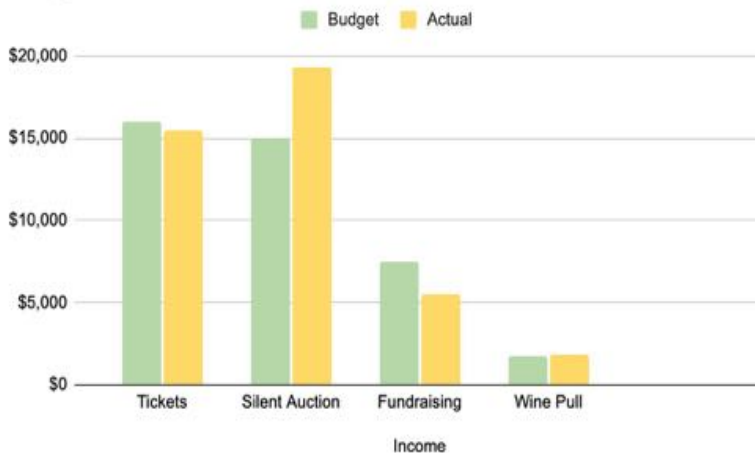


# 5th Annual Soiree

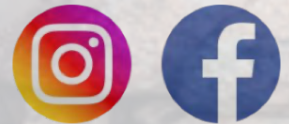
